



The TCSD Foundation is pleased to present our 2015 Annual Report. From January 1 to December 31, 2015, the TCSD Foundation raised a total of \$23,425 from individuals, business and other charitable organizations, including in-kind goods and services critical to our success. These funds were used toward Teacher Grants in excess of \$9,800, our district-focused community newsletter, *The Trumansburg Troubadour*, with two more issues (Volumes 4 and 5) written and produced by student journalists, our KDT! Trumansburg program (\$5,350), other projects described below and our student Award for Community Service (\$500).

We are proud to have supported several projects through our Teacher Grant Program. Projects funded in 2015 included funds for supplies for the Middle School Localvore program, a sound system for the Elementary School After School Program, 'hands-on' math experiences collaboration with Black Locust & Middle School math program, awards to support Youth Art Month programming and special supplies, support towards Middle School Community Read, funds for professional jazz musician to work with the High School jazz ensemble, high school Robotics materials, materials for Ulysses Philomathic Library's preschool storytime. Congratulations to all our recipients, and we look forward to the next grant cycle, with applications being accepted throughout the month of May.
